Background

Linda Sorensen was born in London England in 1953. The family moved to Canada, and settled in Burlington in 1957. Linda has always been creative and gifted and at an early age her talents were recognized. In 1971 at Lord Elgin High School, Linda studied drawing, painting and art history under Robert Bateman, the now renowned international wildlife artist. She went on to study at the Ontario College of Art in Toronto in 1972, before laying down roots in Renfrew County. She was a part of the original back to the land movement that inspired a generation of people who were seeking a simpler way of life away from their complex urban roots. Motherhood, subsistence farming and a rural community nestled in a natural environment fulfilled her creative spirit until she returned to her art some twenty-five years later.

Artist Statement

For almost 40 years my life in the wilderness has shaped my destiny as an artist. My bold, wild, inspired paintings reflect my passionate respect for the natural world.

Immersed in nature, painting on site infuses each peice with the timelessness of the wilderness, the colour and light of the day. Its all about being there... 25 years of hiking, camping and canoe experiences breathes the spirit of adventure that ignites an even greater connection, for me, to each painting and to the earth.

I work in the mediums of oil, acrylic. Photographs and sketches are taken for future reference for larger studio peices.
